Explosive Ordnance Risk Education by DRC Ukraine

Due to the widespread contamination with Explosive Ordnance (EO) across Ukraine, the Danish Refugee Council (DRC) in Ukraine started to provide online sessions on Explosive Ordnance Risk Education (EORE). EORE aims at increasing awareness of children (6-11 years old), teenagers (12-17 years old), and adults (18+ years old) across Ukraine regarding the risks of EO and safe behaviour around them.

All DRC EORE resources will increase your knowledge on:

- How to act in dangerous situations and which areas are more likely to be dangerous
- Rules and algorithms of safe behaviour around EO
- You will be able to move with greater confidence in the area where there was or is an armed conflict.
